

## Undergraduate Programme: Admissions for 2018

The Indian Institute of Science, a leading institution of higher learning with a strong tradition of research, offers a **four-year Bachelor of Science (Research) Programme** which is designed as a balanced blend of core science and interdisciplinary topics to serve as a platform for attractive career opportunities in academia and industry. Students who complete the requirements for the award of the Bachelor of Science (Research) degree will have the option of getting a Master of Science degree by studying at the Institute for a fifth year. Applications are invited for admission to the four-year undergraduate programme at the Institute. ### ELIGIBILITY

Candidates who have completed their II PUC / 12<sup>th</sup> Standard in 2017 and those who are expecting to complete their II PUC / 12<sup>th</sup> Standard in 2018 are eligible to apply. The candidates must have studied **Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics** as main subjects during their II PUC / 12<sup>th</sup> Standard. Candidates who have studied Biology, Statistics, Electronics, Computer Science, etc., in addition to Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics are also eligible to apply. The candidates must have secured a first class or 60% or equivalent grade (relaxed to pass class for SC/ST candidates) in the II PUC / 12<sup>th</sup> Standard examination.

### SELECTION

Based on the merit list of one of the following national examinations: KVPY-SA [appeared in 2016 and selected for the Fellowship], KVPY-SB [appeared in 2017 and selected for the Fellowship], KVPY-SX [appeared in 2017 and selected for the Fellowship], KVPY-SA and SX Fellows selected through the Empowerment Initiative for SC/ST candidates, IIT-JEE-Main [appearing in 2018 and securing a minimum of 60% (GN), 54% (OBC-NCL), 30% (SC/ST/PwD)], IIT-JEE-Advanced [appearing in 2018 and securing a minimum of 60% (GN), 54% (OBC-NCL), 30% (SC/ST/PwD)], and NEET-UG [appearing in 2018 and securing a minimum of 60% (GN), 54% (OBC-NCL), 30% (SC/ST/PwD)].

**Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/Person with disability (PwD) and Kashmiri-Migrant (KM) candidates:** As per Government of India regulations.

### HOW TO APPLY

#### (a) Application Forms (available only online):

The on-line application may be prepared and submitted by accessing the IISc website [www.iisc.ac.in/ug](http://www.iisc.ac.in/ug) with effect from **01.02.2018**. The application fee is **Rs. 500/-** for GN/OBC/KM candidates and **Rs. 250/-** for SC/ST/PwD categories. The fee is non-refundable; any bank or payment gateway service charges must be borne by the applicant).
