New Administrative Block

The old Aerospace building has been renovated and converted into an administrative block. Academic, Purchase, Finance & Accounts and Internal Audit sections, and the Centre for Sponsored Schemes and Projects have started functioning in the block. The Office of Public Relations will also move there shortly. The administrative block is well lighted, ventilated and equipped with modern workstations.

New Shopping Complex

The new shopping complex opposite to the Janatha Bazaar is ready for occupation. The complex will have a supermarket, milk parlour, bakery, tailoring shop, men & women beauty salons, laundry shop, food court and pharmacy. Space has been allotted to various selected agencies and they are likely to start operating in a month's time. An elevator will be provided in the complex.

ODAA and OIR

The Office of Development and Alumni Affairs has moved into a renovated bungalow on Gulmohar Marg, along with the Office of International Relations. These offices have modern facilities with a small conference room.

New E-type Quarters

Construction of 72 new E-type quarters was completed. Allotment of quarters was completed in April.

New Maintenance and Service Center

A new maintenance and service centre has been set up on campus to take care of the electrical, plumbing, carpentry and other civil maintenance needs of the Institute community. The centre functions from the New Boys Hostel and can be contacted 24X7 at 2293 2822/2655/2206.

Office of Career Counselling & Placement (OCCaP)

A new brochure, a comprehensive online portal to handle all placement-related activities and new wi-fi facilities for conduct of tests have been created. 80 companies have visited the campus and 220 job offers were made — 32 offers with CTC above Rs. 20 LPA and 78 with CTC in the range of Rs. 15-20 LPA. OCCaP also organized "IISconnect": an industry interaction event on October 3, 2016, with the aim of securing research jobs for graduating doctoral students. An exclusive Placement Officer has been recruited, who will be joining shortly.
