

Counselling Centre

With effect from 1st January 2017, a “Counselling Centre” has started functioning at the Health Centre. Two consulting psychologists, Dr. Nalini Dwarakanath and Mr. Vikas Ranjan Jha, have been selected to work in the Institute under Dr. Vyjayanthi Subramaniya, the psychiatric consultant at the Health Centre. The Counselling Centre will move shortly to an exclusive location in the faculty club complex.

WeCaRe

A new centre called WeCaRe (Women Empowerment, Children Activities and Recreation) was created in the Institute in January 2017. The centre will conduct activities for women, such as yoga, tailoring and computer coaching, as well as children’s activities.

LED Lights

Rural Electrification Corporation Limited (REC) has supported a project under Corporate Social Responsibility for replacement of existing street lights in the campus with LED lights. The total cost of the project is Rs. 2 crores. Approximately 2200 LED lights will replace the existing street lights. In addition, light points in the Health Centre and JRD Tata Memorial Library will also be replaced with LED. The tender for this work is in advanced stage, for conclusion of contract. Work will commence soon.

DG Sets

The Institute will be installing two 2000KVA capacity DG sets at the main substation, to provide standby power supply to the entire campus. The total cost of this project is Rs. 4.48 crores. The contract is being finalised, and the supply and installation is expected to be completed by end of the year.

Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) II

The Institute has commissioned the second sewage treatment plant of 0.5 MLD capacity at the eastern boundary of the campus, to treat domestic sewage and re-circulate treated water for horticultural purposes. With this plant, there are now two STPs in operation on campus with a total capacity of 1.0 MLD of recycled water. The construction cost of this plant is approximately Rs. 3.4 crores.
