Sub: Providing free tests for general public under National free disease detection services-reg.
Ref: Circular No. NHM/NFDS/District ROP/2019-20, Dated 23.04.2020.

Apropos subject and reference cited, under national free disease detection campaign, the Govt health centres/govt hospitals should provide all available lab testing facilities to general public free of cost. The testing facilities which are not available in Govt health centres, may be outsourced from recognised private labs and provide them to the general public free of cost. The cost for such lab tests have to borne under the said scheme under head of account 6.4.1- Free Services. This program has to be implemented by District Health and Family welfare officers in their respective districts.
