

When asked, MEA officials didn't confirm whether Mr. Modi had raised whether Mr. Modi had raised the issue, but said Ms. Frede-riksen had been "Impressed" with India's vaccination

"We know that COVID is a major concern for the global community so this issue of how both countries are tack-ling COVID came up for discussion...We remain en-gaged with our partners on the WTO [proposal], and it is taking its course," said Ree-nat Sandhu, Secretary (West) at the MEA.
