ENGAGEMENT OF CHEMICAL SAFETY OFFICER

Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore invites applications for EHS Officer – Chemical Safety in the Office of Laboratory Safety and Environmental Health (OLSEH). The details are as follows:

A. Essential Qualification:

- a. Three- or Four year Bachelor's degree in Science, Engineering or EHS/Safety.
- b. Candidate should have passed a PG Diploma in Safety from a recognized Degree granting institution or body. This criterion is relaxable for candidates with a Four year Bachelor's Degree or a Master's Degree in Chemistry/Chemical Engineering or related disciplines.

B. Desirable Qualification:

a. Two years of experience in chemical safety and in developing procedures for safe handling of chemicals in industry/ academic institutions/ regulatory body / laboratory.

OR

b. Master's degree or a higher degree in chemistry/chemical engineering or related disciplines.

C. Job Description:

EHS Officers will be part of the core safety management team at the institute which will be headed by the Institute's Safety committee. Primary responsibilities include:

- a. Develop guidelines and procedures for disposal of chemical waste and waste treatment.
- b. Develop, document, and implement chemical and general EHS protocols at the institute.
- c. Organize periodic training and enabling stakeholders to understand the principles and applications of general EHS issues.
- d. Carry out EHS inspections to assess conformity of various laboratories within the institute.
- e. Suggest corrective actions if any after the inspection, follow-up and help the laboratories in implementing the suggested corrective actions.
- f. Assist in the development of a centralized safety portal (website) for the entire institute which would serve as a repository for safety education, training, and documentation.
- g. Develop guidelines for emergency preparedness and streamline emergency response.
- h. Provide periodic presentations and submit reports with statistics about the status of safety infrastructure, safety practices and their effectiveness at the institute to the Institute's safety committee.
- i. Liaison with concerned authorities for ensuring complete compliance with governmental regulations with regards to safety in the workplace and protection of the environment through prevention of environmental pollution.
- j. Other responsibilities assigned by the safety committee.
- D. **Age limit:** Below 50 years as on the last date for receipt of applications. Relaxation in age is applicable as per GOI norms.

- E. **Monthly Emoluments:** Expected to be in the range of Rs. 28,000 56,000 per month + 24% HRA, depending on qualifications and experience.
- F. **Duration:** Engagement is purely temporary on contract basis for a period of 2 years, on a probation period of four months from the date of your reporting for duty, may be extended for a further period based on satisfactory performance.

How to Apply

- c. The CV must contain photograph, details of education, past work experience relevant to the position, date of birth and address for communication.
- d. The shortlisted candidates will be informed through e-mail about date & time of interview. Candidates are also advised to provide correct information in their online application.
- e. The electronic mode of interview (Zoom Call/Microsoft Team) will be intimated to the candidates in advance. However, the candidates are advised to be prepared to appear in person, if so required.
- f. Candidates may please ensure that they are fulfilling all the requisite criteria prior to registering, failing which, their candidature is liable to be rejected/cancelled.

General Instructions

- a. The Candidate must possess the essential prescribed qualifications on or before the last date of submitting application.
- b. Qualifications other than one prescribed in this advertisement will not be accepted.
- c. Engagement on contract would be subject to medical fitness.
- d. Selected candidates must accept the offer within 2 weeks of the formal letter. Selected candidates must report to the institute within 1 month of the formal letter. Else, the offer will be transferred to waitlisted candidates.
- e. The contract can be terminated at any time by giving one month's notice, by either side.
- f. Candidature/contract of candidate(s) submitting false certificates or suppression/submission of incorrect information shall be liable for termination/disqualification/rejection at any stage.
- g. Candidates should apply through online mode only. Incomplete applications and applications in format other than that displayed on website and application received physically are liable to be rejected.
- h. Prescribed educational qualifications and experience are the minimum eligibilities required and mere fact that a candidate possesses the same shall not entitle him/her for being called for test/interview. The Institute reserves the right to restrict the no. of candidates admitted for interview to a reasonable number, based on qualifications and/or experience.
- i. All Candidates should obtain NOC from the present employer and upload the same online. However, application without NOC shall also be considered, provided the candidate uploads a duly signed undertaking that the NOC will be submitted at the time of Interview.
- j. Applications should be submitted well in advance, without waiting till the last date.
- k. Call letters to attend interview will be sent only to the shortlisted candidates by mail. Candidates are required to check their registered e-mail ID frequently. No correspondence will be made with applicants who are not short-listed/not called for interview.
