- 1. Reservation/concession/relaxations for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/Person with disability (PwD) and Kashmiri-Migrant (KM), Kashmiri Pandits/Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in the Kashmir valley: as per Government of India regulations.
- 2. 10 % Supernumerary Quota over and above the approved intake for the program will be provided to women candidates.
- 3. A minimum of "Pass Class" in the qualifying examination (i.e., 10+2 or equivalent) is required for SC/ST students.
- 4. Applicants applying under the EWS and OBC (as per the central list of OBC available at <a href="https://www.ncbc.nic.in">www.ncbc.nic.in</a>) category must ensure that they have the valid EWS/OBC-NCL Certificates issued on or after 01 April 2023 (i.e., valid in FY: 2023-24) by 31 May 2023.
- 5. **Scholarships:** All the students who join the Institute are eligible for a scholarship from the KVPY/INSPIRE/IISc Promotional Scheme (IIScP), depending upon their mode of entry. Scholarships from many Indian and multinational agencies and business houses are also available for meritorious students. The scholarship amount may vary for different scholarship agencies as per norms.
