A Ph.D. from a recognized university with a minimum of two years of post-doctoral teaching and/or research experience.

 - Experience in econometric modelling is preferred.
 - Excellent academic writing skills, strong organizational and communication abilities, attention to detail, willingness to learn, and the ability to manage multiple projects simultaneously.

 - **Research and Analysis (50%):** Conduct research, data analysis, and preparation of policy briefs.
 - **Outreach and Coordination (50%):** Organize events and contribute to science-policy outreach activities.
